The 55% and 41% reductions are based upon casualty data, for the core fixed and core mobile cameras only, for the three years ending March 2010 compared to the baseline data. An excel spreadsheet displaying this is on our website. It has since come to our attention that there was an omission of one KSI casualty in the original calculation, making a variance of 0.2%, so the percentage changes should now read 54% and 41% respectively.</p> |
